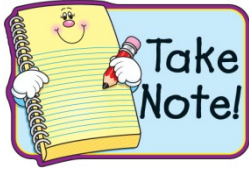

Fr. Doss is planning a pilgrimage of 9 nights/11 days to the Holy Land for April 2018. **An information evening will be held on Thursday, Sept. 14th at 7 pm.**

This trip to the Holy Land will cost about \$4000 per person. This includes:

- International flight, including taxes and fuel surcharge
- Accommodation / double room / Half Board basis (includes breakfast and evening meal) in 4-star hotels as follows: three (3) nights in Nazareth at Golden Crown Old City or similar; one (1) night in Jericho at Jericho Resort Hotel or similar; five (5) nights in Bethlehem at Manger Square Hotel or similar
- All tours and transfers by private modern tourist coach
- Services of English-speaking licensed tourist guide
- Entrance fees to all sites visited
- Meet and assist upon arrival and departure
- All tips
- Whispers Audio system for groups per 25 passengers
- Daily Masses

New Diocesan Logo

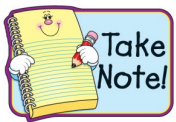


How can one describe the heart of a diocese, how can one reflect all the experiences and dreams of a diocese? With a diocesan logo!

Our new logo is made up of several elements. The majestic facade of our Cathedral proclaims the beauty and strength of our Church that has been here in Manitoba for 200 years. Our treasure of faith continues to inspire hope for the future and welcomes everyone.

Below the facade, the two waves symbolize the ever-flowing stream of life. From the time when Father Provencher and companions arrived at the junction of the two rivers, Red and Assiniboine, faith in Jesus Christ flows through our Manitoban land as a powerful river. The waters of our baptism carry us toward an ongoing renewal of our Church so that each Christian can be a true disciple and missionary, a witness of Jesus Christ – the Living Water who quenches the thirst of humankind.

The diocesan logo is drawn with the official colours of our diocese: yellow and blue. Yellow is the colour of the prairies which “overflow” – according to the motto of Bishop Provencher – with a bountiful harvest of faith and love. Blue represents Jesus Christ, the Living Water, the waters of our baptism and the Blessed Virgin Mary, patron saint of our diocese, Mother of God and Mother of the Church.
