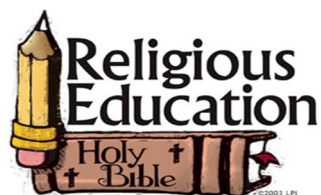
“Or who has given the Lord anything that he may be repaid?” Rom 11:35

Saints Faith garden project update

Thanks to volunteer efforts, the garden at St. Benedict's is producing well in spite of below average rainfall. Lots of beets, zucchini and cucumbers continue to be harvested; more than we can sell. First delivery was made to Wpg. Harvest of 57 lbs of beets. This week is the last pick of beans. Corn is ready; expect spaghetti squash in 2 weeks. Biggest disappointment so far is the tomato crop. We are picking green; otherwise the birds are pecking at them.

So far in 2017 we've raised over \$4000 for this D & P garden project account at Canada Foodgrains Bank. With 4X matching funds, that is over \$20,000 for international food aid for Ethiopia.
