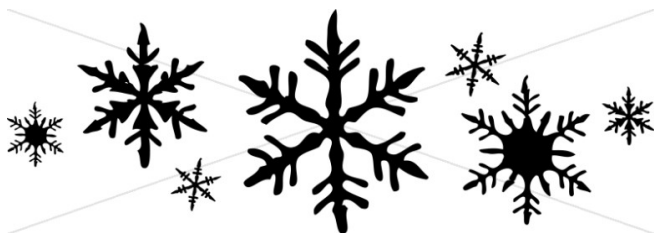
Winnipeg Pops Orchestra
