Palm Sunday April 10th, 2022

The Week That Changed the World

Palm Sunday, where we commemorate Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem, marks the beginning of Holy Week. During this week, we commemorate the Passion of Christ and the events leading up to it.

Holy Thursday begins the Easter Triduum, the most sacred time of the liturgical year. Jesus celebrated the Passover feast with his disciples, the Last Supper, on the night he was betrayed and arrested. The Mass of the Lord's Supper celebrates the institution of the Eucharist and the ordained priesthood.

On Good Friday, the most somber day of the church's year, we commemorate the crucifixion of our Lord. On this day, we venerate the Cross; showing respect for what it represents.

On Holy Saturday, we remember Jesus' entombment and prayerfully reflect on his sacrifice. We wait in anticipation for the Resurrection of Jesus and his victory over death and sin.

At the Easter Vigil Mass, we celebrate the most holiest of nights. We start in darkness, the Easter Candle will be lit to represent Jesus' triumph over darkness. Those coming into the church will receive the Sacraments of Initiation and we all renew our baptismal promises.

We have spent the last 40 days praying, fasting and almsgiving to prepare for Easter. As we enter into Holy Week, let us never forget what our Lord did for us as we journey towards Calvary.
