Life Changing Effect of the Resurrection

With the celebration of the Resurrection of Jesus on Easter Sunday, the church moves into the 50 day Easter Season that ends with the Feast of Pentecost.

In today's Gospel reading, we hear how Jesus appeared to his disciples after his Resurrection and sends them out after receiving the gift of the Holy Spirit. Thomas at first did not believe the other disciples, and it was not until he touched the Risen Lord for himself that he believed.

During the Easter Season, you will notice that the first reading is no longer from the Old Testament, but from the Acts of the Apostles. The reading of Acts presents the life, growth and witness of the early Church. We hear about the life changing effect the Resurrection of the Lord had on his Apostles.

During the Easter season, we are called to focus on the celebration of the Resurrection and to keep looking forward from that event. We are called to reflect on how the Resurrection has changed us and how we can let Jesus be known to the world.

The Parish Finance Council is Seeking New Members

The parish finance council is currently seeking new members. The parish finance council meets once a month at the church on the second Tuesday of each month at 6:30 p.m., excluding July and August.

Per Canon Law, each parish must have a Finance Council (Trustees) made up of the pastor and at least three other members. The finance council's task is to help the pastor in financial administration matters of the parish.

Members of the finance council must be Catholics, parishioners, of good character, fulfilling their duties toward the Church and the priests, prudent and capable of dealing with public affairs. They must be ready to help the pastor in all that concerns the temporal administration of the parish. The pastor considers these collaborators as valuable aids and, together, they see it as their duty to administer the Church goods according to the Diocesan Regulations.

We are asking parishioners to pray and discern if being a member of the finance council is a ministry they can provide to their parish. If you feel called to this ministry or would like more information please contact the office.
