Up The Mountain

The Gospel reading for the second Sunday of Lent is always the story of Jesus' Transfiguration. Jesus led Peter, James and John up a high mountain, and he was transfigured before them.

Mountains are mentioned frequently in the Bible. A mountain is a symbol of nearness to God. They are quiet, solitary spaces. Jesus often went up the mountain by himself to pray. Mountains are places of prayer, healing and revelation.

However, climbing up a mountain is not easy. It takes focus, stamina and perseverance. What were the Apostles thinking when they were climbing the mountain? They did not know where Jesus was leading them, but they continued to follow.

And what did they experience when they finished climbing? They saw firsthand a small glimpse of the Lord in all of his divine glory and splendor.

God calls each us to follow him, but this will not always be easy. The Lenten practices of prayer, fasting and almsgiving are to help us strengthen our faith and grow closer to God.

Unlike the Apostles, who did not know what was to come at the end of the journey, we do. As we approach the celebration of Jesus' resurrection at Easter, we know that Our Lord has overcome death and sin. We know that good has triumphed over evil.

The transfiguration not only offers us a glimpse of Jesus in all his glory, it also offers us a foretaste of what God promises each of us in the fullness of the Kingdom.

Thank you for your continued generosity during this challenging time of pandemic.

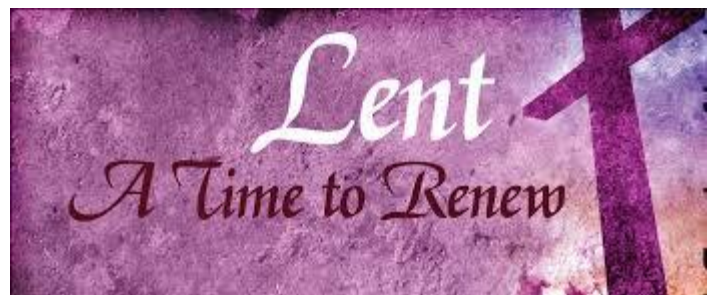
Sacraments

Mass Information During Time of Pandemic PLEASE

Due to the most recent restrictions due to Code Red:

1. Only **35** people are allowed at each Mass. The doors of the church will be locked at the beginning of Mass.
2. Two-meter physical distancing is **obligatory** in the church, gathering space and parking lot.
3. When being seated kindly sit **singly** at the pre-measured number signs. If you notice 2 numbered signs together, please leave it for couples.
4. Masks are obligatory (if you cannot wear a mask for medical reasons please see Sister Maria).
5. Please arrive at least 5 – 10 minutes before Mass. This is to ensure that the Greeter can check you in by the time Mass begins. Doors will be locked once Mass begins.
6. If you would like to attend a weekend Mass, please contact the office no later than noon on Friday to add your name to the list of participants. If you have signed up but are unable to attend please contact the office before noon Friday.
7. There is no need to sign up beforehand for the weekday Masses; however, participants will have to sign their name to a list upon arrival.
8. For the purpose of contact tracing, if ever needed, please add your **phone number** next to your name.
