## 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022

### *Call to Discipleship*

In today's Gospel, we read about Jesus calling the first disciples: Simon Peter, James and John. Jesus calls them and they left everything and followed him.

The call to discipleship is not only for a select few; it is not only for the ordained; it is for all of us. Jesus calls each of us to be his disciples, to follow him and make him known to others.

Each year, the Holy Father asks for our prayers for a specific intention each month. Back in October 2021, Pope Francis' prayer intention was For Missionary Disciples. Let us reflect on this call to discipleship that Pope Francis calls us to in his October 2021 message:

*"Jesus asks us all, and you as well, to be missionary disciples. Are you ready?"*

*It's enough to be available to answer his call and to live united to the Lord in the most common daily things — work, meeting other people, our daily duties, the chance events of each day — allowing ourselves to be guided always by the Holy Spirit.*

*If Christ moves you, if you do things because Christ is guiding you, others will notice it easily.*

*And your testimony of life will inspire admiration, and admiration inspires others to ask themselves, "How is it possible for this person to be this way?," "What is the source of the love with which this person treats everyone — the kindness and good humor?"*

*Let us remember that the mission is not proselytism; the mission is based on an encounter between people, on the testimony of men and women who say, "I know Jesus, and I'd like you to know him too."*

*Brothers and sisters, let us pray that every baptized person may be engaged in evangelization, available to the mission, by being witnesses of a life that has the flavour of the Gospel."*

## New Pandemic Directives Change in Mass Capacity Effective February 8, 2022

On February 2, the government announced changes to the COVID-19 restrictions. They are to take effect on February 8 and expire on February 22.

Indoor religious gatherings are now limited to 25 percent capacity or a total of 250 people, whichever is lower. With these new restrictions and to allow for social distancing, **we can now have 85 people per Mass starting February 8.**

Parishioners will no longer have to sign up beforehand, but will be asked to sign in when they come to Mass. As well, the cohort system will no longer be used.

## First Nations Delegation to Meet Pope Francis in Rome in late March 2022

The Canadian Catholic Bishops, Assembly of First Nations, Métis National Council, and Inuit Tapiriit Kanatami are pleased to announce that the delegation to Rome to meet with Pope Francis, originally planned for December 2021, is now scheduled to take place at the end of March and early April of this year.

In light of the rapid spread of the Omicron variant, both in Canada and throughout the world, a prudent decision was made in December to postpone the delegation out of concern for the safety of all delegates, recognizing the uncertainty regarding travel and the fluid nature of the situation.

Working closely with the Vatican, new dates have been confirmed. The Holy Father is now scheduled to meet with individual Indigenous delegations the week of March 28, 2022. A final audience with all participants will take place on Friday, April 1, 2022.



**Pandemic Directives**

**Cohorts Effective January 29, 2022**

**Until February 8, 2022**

Currently, indoor faith-based gatherings are limited to 25%  
capacity or 25 people, whichever is lesser. This restriction  
may be increased to 25% capacity of the space to a  
maximum of 250 people, by separating attendees into  
cohorts of 25 people each.

For our parish, we are allowed to have two separate cohorts.  
The cohorts must not mingle and will be using separate  
entrances and exits.

Cohort 1 is seated in the right side of the church and uses  
the main doors of the church to enter and exit.

Cohort 2 is seated in the left side of the church and uses the  
southeast back door to enter and exit. Please note that this  
door will be locked once Mass begins. Please use the main  
doors if you arrive after Mass begins.

Weddings, funerals and baptisms are limited to 25 people.

Please note that by decision of the Archdiocese, parishes will  
not require the faithful to present proof of vaccination.

These restrictions will go until midnight, February 8, and  
then new restrictions will take place. Please see the new  
restrictions on the second page of the bulletin.

Just a reminder to keep on following the protocols as so  
many of you have been doing so faithfully and patiently.
