Who Is My Neighbour?

In today's Gospel, we read the story of the Good Samaritan. Jesus gave this story as an answer to the question 'Who is my neighbour?' Jesus answered that the man who showed mercy was a neighbour to the man who fell victim to robbery.

We are called to be good neighbours to one another. To show one another mercy, compassion and forgiveness.

When you walk into our parish you see a sign that says the following:

We are called to be neighbours to everyone we encounter not just those we agree with, who look like us, who come from the same country, etc. We are called to love regardless of our differences, for everyone we meet is a child of God.

In his Angelus on July 10, 2016 Pope Francis stated:

"Today's liturgy presents us with the parable of the 'Good Samaritan'. This passage, this simple and inspiring story, indicates a way of life, which has as its main point not ourselves, but others, with their difficulties, whom we encounter on our journey and who challenge us..."

Jesus concludes, saying: "Go and do likewise" What a great lesson! And he repeats it to each of us: "Go and do likewise", be a neighbour to the brother or sister whom you see in trouble...Let us ask ourselves — each of us responding in his own heart — let us ask ourselves: Is our faith fruitful?

Do I act as a neighbour or simply pass by? Am I one of those who selects people according to my own liking? It is good to ask ourselves these questions, and to ask them often, because in the end we will be judged on the works of mercy."

Parish Perogy Fundraiser Being Planned For September 2022

The making and selling of perogies are spread over two days:

Monday 8 a.m. to approx. 2 p.m.:

Tuesday 8 a.m. to approx. 4 p.m.:

At least 35 volunteers are needed and tasks include rolling dough; pinching perogies; packaging, filling and selling orders and cleaning up. Lunch will be provided.
