Pentecost June 5th, 2022

Today, we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost, which concludes the Easter season. At Pentecost we commemorate the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the disciples. After they received the Holy Spirit, the disciples went out and spread the Gospel to the world. Because of this, Pentecost is also known as the birthday of the Church.

The mission to make Jesus known to the world was not just a mission for the Apostles, but for every Christian. We are all called to be disciples of Jesus: to know him, grow closer to him, let him transform us and make him known to others through our words and actions. The gifts of the Holy Spirit that we receive are to help us live as disciples of Jesus.

At Baptism, we receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit and these are strengthened at Confirmation. Just like Baptism, Confirmation leaves on our souls an indelible imprint, the seal of the Holy Spirit.

"It is evident from its celebration that the effect of the sacrament of Confirmation is the special outpouring of the Holy Spirit as once granted to the apostles on the day of Pentecost" (CCC 1302).

"From this fact, Confirmation brings an increase and deepening of baptismal grace: it roots us more deeply in the divine filiation which makes us cry, "Abba! Father!" it unites us more firmly to Christ; it increases the gifts of the Holy Spirit in us; it renders our bond with the Church more perfect; it gives us a special strength of the Holy Spirit to spread and defend the faith by word and action as true witnesses of Christ, to confess the name of Christ, boldly, and never to be ashamed of the Cross" (CCC 1303).

Being a faithful witness to Christ is not easy, especially in such a secular society. Let us continue to pray for the youth of our parish who recently received the Sacraments of Confirmation and First Communion. May we be a parish where they, and all, are welcomed and can grow in their faith.

Perogy Fundraiser Being Planned For September 2022

The making and selling of perogies has been an excellent fundraiser and community builder for our parish in the past and we are planning towards having the first perogy fundraiser in over two years in September 2022. However, in order for this fundraiser to take place we need volunteers.

The making and selling of perogies are spread over two days:

Monday 8 a.m. to approx. 2 p.m.:

At least 20 volunteers are needed and tasks include peeling potatoes; making dough balls; setting up tables and cleaning up. Coffee and snacks will be provided.

Tuesday 8 a.m. to approx. 4 p.m.:

At least 35 volunteers are needed and tasks include rolling dough; pinching perogies; packaging, filling and selling orders and cleaning up. Lunch will be provided.

All are welcome, even if you can only spare a few hours, and training will be provided. At this time, we do not know the exact date in September, but we are asking those who are interested in helping to put their names on the sign up sheet on the counter in the gathering space.
