Repent and Turn to the Lord

In today's Gospel, we read about the parable of the fig tree. The man who had the fig tree wanted to cut it down because it was bearing no fruit. The gardener asked to leave it for one year and the gardener will tend to the tree, hoping it will bear fruit.

The parable of the fig tree is an example of God's patience with us. God works within us so we can bear the good fruits. There is hope as God will not abandon us. He will give us opportunities to grow.

However, we must respond to what God is willing to do for us. In today's Gospel, we also hear Jesus proclaiming "..but unless you repent, you will all perish just as they did." While God is patient and merciful with us, it does not mean we can just ignore him and his teachings. Jesus desires that we get right with God.

By calling us to repentance, God is asking us to honestly and in humility examine our relationship with him. We are to answer what place God has in our hearts and to be aware of things that take us away from him and areas we need to work on. The goal is always growing closer to the Lord and doing our best to live out his teachings.

In this season of Lent, we are called in a deeper way to honestly look at our walk with God and cultivate our relationship with him. Some of the ways that we can cultivate this relationship deeper is through prayer, going to Mass, reading the Bible, receiving the Eucharist and going to confession. This is a lifelong journey and we are called to not give up as God will not give up on us.
