## Pentecost Sunday May 23, 2021

### *The Gift of the Holy Spirit*

Pentecost Sunday marks the end of the seven week Easter season, and fully reveals the Most Holy Trinity. Pentecost is derived from the Greek word "*pentecoste*," meaning fiftieth.

Fifty days after Easter Sunday, we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the first disciples, and the beginning of their ministry to make disciples of all nations (the Great Commission). Pentecost is known as the birthday of the church.

At the end of Luke's Gospel, Jesus promised the Apostles they would be '*clothed with power from on high*' Luke 24:49. The coming of the Holy Spirit fulfills this promise. The gifts of the Holy Spirit that the disciples received enabled them to carry out the Great Commission.

At Baptism, we receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit and these gifts are strengthened at Confirmation. These Sacraments leave an indelible mark on our soul, and as a result, we can only validly receive them once.

The Holy Spirit, Third Person of the Holy Trinity, whom we adore and glorify with the Father and the Son, is living within us. The gift of the Holy Spirit was given to us freely and cannot be returned.

The gifts we receive from the Holy Spirit allow us to live a life for God. He strengthens us to live our faith and to be public witnesses for Jesus. He guides us in the path of salvation.

Through an open mind and heart, prayer, reception of the Sacraments and reading of Sacred Scripture we can grow closer to the Holy Spirit and let him work within us to live out our Baptismal call to holiness.



## **COVID-19 Restrictions Update Effective May 9, 2021**

New Code Red Alert restrictions for all of Manitoba came into effect on May 9, and will be applicable until May 30.

The most significant changes are that Churches are closed to the public. No religious gatherings may take place.

Weddings, funerals and baptisms continue to be permitted, with a capacity of 10 people in addition to an officiant, photographer, funeral director, etc. Masks must be worn at all times.


