The Mystery of the Holy Trinity

Every year on the first Sunday after Pentecost, we celebrate the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity. There is one God, and in this one God there are three Divine Persons, the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

The three persons of the Trinity are distinct in their relations to one another, but are equally eternal, possessing one Divine Nature.

The Holy Trinity is the foundation and central mystery of our Christian faith. It is a mystery that can only be known through divine revelation as fully understanding God is above our human limitations.

Each of us was created to know and love God. God desires for each of us to enter into the perfect unity of the Trinity as his children.

St. John Paul II described the Holy Trinity as a "Divine Family," a community of persons who give themselves completely to each other and who wishes to share itself, its life, with us.

At baptism, we receive sanctifying grace. This is the life of God, the Holy Trinity, within our soul. God shares his life and love with us. This life within us gives us the great capacity to know and love God, but also to share God and his love to others.

"The feast of the Holy Trinity makes us contemplate the mystery of a God who incessantly creates, redeems and sanctifies, always with love and for love, and to every creature that welcomes him, he gives the gift of reflecting a ray of his beauty, goodness and truth."
