Multicultural Sunday Liturgy Followed by potluck luncheon and silent auction

The celebration will start with an **entrance procession** consisting of representatives of the many cultures in our parish - hopefully wearing traditional clothing and carrying the flag of their country (if you don't have a flag you are still welcome in the procession). The procession will be a great place for families to get involved.

Music: We would also like to have people join in the singing, even if you aren't a member of any of the choirs. If you play an instrument and can help accompany the singing, please bring it along.

After the multicultural Mass, all are invited to a **potluck lunch** downstairs. It is free but we ask that you bring food that your family would normally serve if you were having a light lunch. Just bring enough food to feed your family but it will be shared with others.

There will also be a silent auction downstairs and tickets will be available to buy at the lunch.
