## 32<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

November 8, 2020

### *Ownership of Faith*

As we approach the end of the church year, we are asked to consider the end times, our own as well as the world's. The exact time of Jesus' return or our death cannot be determined, but as Jesus teaches his disciples in today's Gospel one must remain vigilant so they will not be unprepared.

The five wise bridesmaids were prepared with flasks of oil for their lamps to meet the bridegroom. The five foolish bridesmaids did not bring any oil and because of their lack of preparedness, they missed the bridegroom when he came.

Why did the wise bridesmaids not share their oil? The wise bridesmaids responded that there would not be enough for everyone. They had to go get their own. Ultimately, each of us is responsible for our relationship with God.

There is an expression "God has no grandchildren." This means that each of us must cultivate our own relationship with God. Our parents may have brought us to the faith, but the decision to follow God is ours alone.

This does not mean that we have to journey alone. We are all part of the communion of saints; the spiritual solidarity which binds together the faithful on earth, the souls in purgatory and the saints in heaven. Others can teach us, guide us and be companions on the journey. However, the ultimate decision to say "yes" to God is ours alone, no one can make it for us.

The decision to say "yes" to God is not a one-time deal. It is a decision we must freely decide to make throughout our life. God invites each of us to be with him, but has given us free will. The choice is ours.

rest in peace.

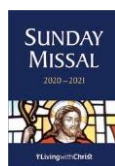

## Mass Information During Time of Pandemic PLEASE

Due to the most recent restrictions due to Code Red:

1. Only **50** people are allowed at each Mass. The doors of the church will be locked at the beginning of Mass.
2. Two-meter physical distancing is **obligatory** in the church, gathering space and parking lot.
3. When being seated kindly sit **singly** at the pre-measured number signs. If you notice 2 numbered signs together, please leave it for couples.
4. Masks are obligatory (if you cannot wear a mask for medical reasons please see Sister Maria).
5. Please arrive at least 5 – 10 minutes before Mass. This is to ensure that the Greeter can check you in by the time Mass begins. Doors will be locked once Mass begins.
6. If you would like to attend a weekend Mass, please contact the office no later than noon on Friday to add your name to the list of participants. If you have signed up but are unable to attend please contact the office before noon Friday.
7. There is no need to sign up beforehand for the weekday Masses; however, participants will have to sign their name to a list upon arrival.
8. For the purpose of contact tracing, if ever needed, please add your **phone number** or **email** next to your name.
