Psalm 23

The Feast of Christ the King marks the end of the Church's liturgical year. When we began the church's liturgical year on December 1, 2019 with the first Sunday of Advent, we never imagined the year that was to unfold.

This feast is in honor of Jesus Christ as Lord over all creation. Pope Pius XI instituted this feast in 1925, in the aftermath of World War 1 and during the 16th centenary of the council of Nicaea (325). This feast marks the end of the Church's liturgical year.

Andrew Dung-Lac, a Vietnamese priest, was one of 117 people who were martyred in Vietnam between 1820 and 1862. In 1988, Pope John Paul II canonized the 117 Vietnamese Martyrs.
