### *Come Lord Jesus*

Advent is the season where we await the coming of our Savior Jesus Christ with joyful expectation. We await both the Christmas feast of Christ's Incarnation and his Second Coming at the end of time.

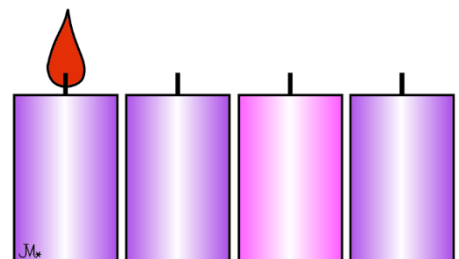
Pope Francis said, "Advent is the time we are given to welcome the Lord who comes to encounter us, and also to verify our longing for God, to look forward and prepare ourselves for Christ's return." (Angelus December 3 2017).

This week the reading from Mark's Gospel presents the theme of the Lord's return at the end of time. Jesus emphasizes the need for watchfulness so that one will be ready when the Son of Man comes. While some try to predict when the end times will occur, only the Father knows.

This call for watchfulness is a reminder to live our lives in Christ. To keep him in our minds and hearts. Jesus calls us to continual transformation and conversion. We are called to be vigilant in our faith life and to be aware of things that may take us away from the Lord.

In today's second reading, Paul tells the Corinthians that Jesus has given them the spiritual gifts to strengthen them to the end. The Corinthian church had its share of problems but God was always there with them.

We are human and we are all a work in progress. God understands. He knows our struggles, weaknesses and sufferings. Despite our imperfections, he does not give up on his people. He is a faithful and loving Father. Like the Corinthians, we have also been given spiritual gifts and God will give us the strength we need.

### Saint Andrew

Andrew, along with his brother Simon Peter, was one of the twelve disciples of Jesus Christ. According to tradition, Andrew was crucified in Patras (in Greece). He asked to be nailed to a cross different from the Cross of Jesus. He was crucified on a diagonal or X shaped cross, which has become known as St. Andrew's Cross. Andrew is the patron saint of fishers and singers, and many countries including Scotland.



### Saint Francis Xavier

Francis was born in Spain in 1506. He was one of the first members of the Society of Jesus (Jesuits). He spent many years working as a missionary with the peoples of Goa India, Southeast Asia and Japan. He died in 1552 on the way from Goa to China. He was canonized in 1622 by Gregory XV, and is the patron saint of missions.
