### Stewardship

In today's Gospel reading, we hear the story of the widow's mite; where the widow gave to the treasury all that she had, while the rich gave out of their abundance.

The issue is not about rich vs poor. It is about giving back to God from the blessings we have been given. Giving back to God was not done as an afterthought for the widow.

We cannot forget that God is the giver of all and we are called to respond with generous and responsible use of our resources. We are called to be good stewards of what has been given to us and to share the gifts and blessings we have with God and others out of love and thanksgiving. This includes not only our financial resources, but time and talents as well.

Money is not inherently bad. We often hear the phrase '*money is the root of all evil*'; however, the Bible does not say this. The actual phrase is '*For the love of money is a source of all kinds of evil.*' (1 Timothy 6.10). The problem is when we prioritize money over loving God and others.

Money is a necessity in this world. We need it to live and function. God does not ask that we give everything away so that we cannot adequately house, feed and clothe ourselves or our families. The important thing is not to be greedy with what we have and not to let things of this world become more important than loving God and others.

Everyone is in a different position in life. Some are in a place to give back more than others and this can change in ones life. Ultimately, it is not about how much we give, but with how much faith and love we give it.


## 'Better Together' Marriage Preparation Sessions Starts November 25, 2021

### Government of Manitoba Updated Pandemic Directives Effective October 26, 2021

New provincial restrictions came into effect on October 26, 2021. There are no changes to the size of faith-based gatherings. The health orders permit indoor sizes for faith-based gatherings to 25 people or 33 percent capacity, whichever is greater. This means that our maximum limit with physical distancing in church remains at approximately 80 people.

Funerals, weddings, and baptisms are limited to 150 people or 50% of capacity, whichever is lower. In order to maintain social distancing in our church, approximately 80 people are permitted.

**Please note that by decision of the Archdiocese, parishes will not require the faithful to present proof of vaccination.**

Masks must be worn in all indoor public places, including places of worship and physical distancing of two metres for everyone not living in the same household must be maintained.

If you would like to attend a weekend Mass, please call or email the office the week prior to book a space. We still need to have a list of names and numbers of all those attending for the purpose of contact tracing.
