## 27<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

October 4, 2020

### God of Peace

*"Let me now sing of my friend...concerning his vineyard."*  
(Isaiah 5:1)

Vineyards appear in Scripture time and again. Isaiah's song of the vineyard seems to be a gloomy tale for Israel – a carefully cultivated vineyard bearing only wild grapes, and an owner who allows it to fall to ruin.

While Isaiah does not guarantee what God will do with his people, it is pretty certain that if nothing changes and they continue in their sin, they will experience the effects of cutting themselves off from God. But even in the midst of this grim story, there is hope. God does not give up! Yes, God expects to see fruit from his people, precisely because he knows we can bear fruit. When we do not, God constantly calls us back and offers us his help. That is cause for hope.

*"Have no anxiety at all,"* says St. Paul to the Philippians (Philippians 4:6). We may wonder if Paul is really serious. How can our lives be anxiety free? Doesn't he know how hard life can get? Yes, he does! He has suffered much and knows the power of God.

His advice...pray! and *"the peace of God that surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus"* (Philippians 4:7).

When we bring our needs to the Lord, we find a peace that we did not know before. Our problems may not disappear; but let us be assured that God will give us the strength and wisdom to work through them.

May we open ourselves to his Holy Spirit who will help us fix our minds and our hearts on *"whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is gracious"* (Philippians 4:8). And then *"the God of peace"* will be with us. Our anxieties will gradually diminish as we deepen our confidence in our living Father who loves us unconditionally, cares for us, forgives us, and reaches out to us.



## **New COVID-19 Restrictions**

The Provincial government updated restrictions on public gatherings in Winnipeg and outlying municipalities. As of Monday, September 28, Masses will still be maintained at 30% (approx. 70 people) of building capacity, with two metre physical distancing, which is obligatory. However, baptisms, weddings and funerals have a limit of 10 people and other including the priest.

Masks are obligatory as soon as one enters the gathering space as well as in the church. If anyone has a medical reason for not wearing a mask, please see Sister Maria.

There is a ten-person limit on indoor and outdoor gatherings, such as meetings and catechism. Physical distancing must be maintained as well as the wearing of masks.

Thank you for your continued patience and care for one another during this time of pandemic.
