27th Sunday in Ordinary Time October 2nd, 2022 *Faith*

In his Angelus on October 10, 2021, Pope Francis asked people to reflect on their faith while reflecting on that day's Gospel reading, in which Jesus urges a rich young man, "Go, sell what you have, and give to the poor ... then come, follow me."

"Faith is a question of freedom, it is a question of love. Here is a first test: what is faith for me? If it is mainly a duty or a bargaining chip, we are off track, because salvation is a gift and not a duty, it is free and cannot be bought. The first thing to do is to free ourselves of a commercial and mechanical faith, which insinuates the false image of an accountant God, a controlling God, not a father. And very often in life we experience this "commercial" relationship of faith: I do this, so that God will give me that.

.. Is your faith, is my faith tired? Do you want to reinvigorate it? Look for God's gaze: sit in adoration, allow yourself to be forgiven in Confession, stand before the Crucified One. In short, let yourself be loved by him. This is the starting point of faith: letting oneself be loved by him, by he who is father. After the question and the gaze there is — the third and final step — an invitation from Jesus, who says: "You lack one thing". What was that rich man lacking? Giving, gratuitousness. It is perhaps what we are missing too. We often do the bare minimum, whereas Jesus invites us to do the maximum possible. How many times are we satisfied with doing our duties — the precepts, a few prayers, and many things like that — whereas God, who gives us life, asks us for leaps of life!

Today we can ask ourselves: "At what point is my faith? Do I experience it as something mechanical, like a relationship of duty or interest with God? Do I remember to nourish it by letting myself be looked at and loved by Jesus"? Letting oneself be gazed at and loved by Jesus; letting Jesus look at us, love us. "And, attracted by him, do I respond freely, with generosity, with all my heart?"

In today's Gospel, the Apostles say to Jesus 'Increase our faith!" While the Gospel Pope Francis reflected on in his Angelus is different than today's Gospel, the reflection on one's faith is always applicable. May we honestly reflect on our faith and ask ourselves the question Pope Francis asked in his Angelus "What is faith for me?"
