World Mission Sunday

This Sunday is World Mission Sunday and Pope Francis has chosen for this year's theme "You shall be my witnesses" (Acts 1:8).

In his message for World Mission Sunday 2022, Pope Francis reflects on how every Christian is called to bear witness to Christ.

"You shall be my witnesses – The call of every Christian to bear witness to Christ. This is the central point, the heart of Jesus' teaching to the disciples, in view of their being sent forth into the world. ...In a similar way, every Christian is called to be a missionary and witness to Christ. And the Church, the community of Christ's disciples, has no other mission than that of bringing the Gospel to the entire world by bearing witness to Christ..."

...when it comes to Christian witness, the observation of Saint Paul VI remains ever valid: "Modern man listens more willingly to witnesses than to teachers, and if he does listen to teachers, it is because they are witnesses" (Evangelii Nuntiandi, 41).

For this reason, the testimony of an authentic Christian life is fundamental for the transmission of the faith. On the other hand, the task of proclaiming Christ's person and the message is equally necessary...

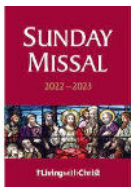
In evangelization, then, the example of a Christian life and the proclamation of Christ are inseparable. One is at the service of the other. They are the two lungs with which any community must breathe, if it is to be missionary. This kind of complete, consistent and joyful witness to Christ will surely be a force of attraction also for the growth of the Church in the third millennium. I exhort everyone to take up once again the courage, frankness and parrhesia of the first Christians, in order to bear witness to Christ in word and deed in every area of life."

On this World Mission Sunday we are reminded that we are called in humility to bear witness to Christ through both our words and actions.

Mother Teresa: No Greater Love November 2 and 3, 2022

Mother Teresa: No Greater Love, the newest documentary film from the Knights of Columbus, will be premiered in Manitoba theatres this Nov. 2 and 3 (Winnipeg, Brandon, Winkler). In Winnipeg, the film will be presented at 7 pm at the Landmark Cinemas 8 Grant Park, 1120 Grant Ave.

The film premiered in the U.S. earlier this month and was a smashing box-office success. In fact, it earned more than \$1.2 million in ticket sales and Supreme Knight Patrick Kelly announced that the Knights would allocate all of the revenue it receives from ticket sales to charitable purposes and efforts that advance the legacy of Mother Teresa. The documentary was released to commemorate the 25th anniversary of Mother Teresa's passing.
