Humbly Following The Lord

“Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus...

Humbly regard others as more important than yourselves.”

(Philippians 2:3)

Jesus did not come to win an argument; he came to win our hearts. By humbling himself, he showed that his love is real and unconditional. Jesus asks us to follow his example. Just as he came not to serve, he asks us to serve each other. He asks us to win each other's hearts rather than try to break each other's wills.

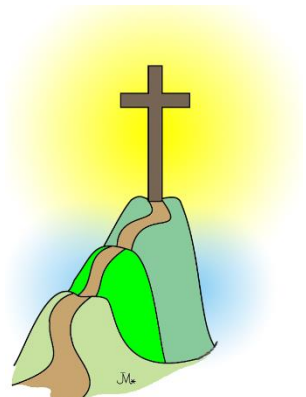
But this is not always easy...neither is it always successful. However, God has given us his Holy Spirit. He longs to transform us and fill us with his humility, kindness and patience.

In the Gospel, Jesus told his listeners a parable of two sons whose father asked them to work in the fields. The first refused, but later “changed his mind” and the other said he would go, but he did not.

Just as the young man changed his mind and went, the same is true for us. “No”, does not have to be our final answer. Just because we may have said no to God, he has not turned his back on us. We can always change our mind, repent, and say yes. There is always the chance for a new beginning.

That impulsive first “no” or that obstinate “never” does not necessarily lock us into it. Like the first son, like the prodigal son, we can always turn back to our loving Father. All vestiges of our “no” can be wiped away.”

May we have the humility of Jesus who, through God, empties himself in embracing our humanity. May we empty ourselves and be filled with the fullness of the God who longs to be one with us. May we hear him say to us as he said to Jesus in the Jordan, “You are my son; you are my daughter; in you my soul delights.”
